- a. Elections shall be held in a manner prescribed by the Board of Directors, provided there shall be an opportunity at such elections for nominations from the floor before the election.
- b. If a nominee is unopposed, they may be elected by acclamation of the Membership.
- c. Absentee votes are permitted.
  1. Absentee votes shall be cast on ballots provided by the Secretary.
  2. Absentee votes shall be signed and dated by the absent member and shall be delivered to the Secretary at least two calendar days prior to the voting date.
- d. Proxy votes are not permitted.

Since residents will be getting together for the National Night Out Potluck Dinner on August 5, 2008, the election will be held that night. If you will be out of town and would like an absentee ballot, please contact Carol at: 713 524-5146.
